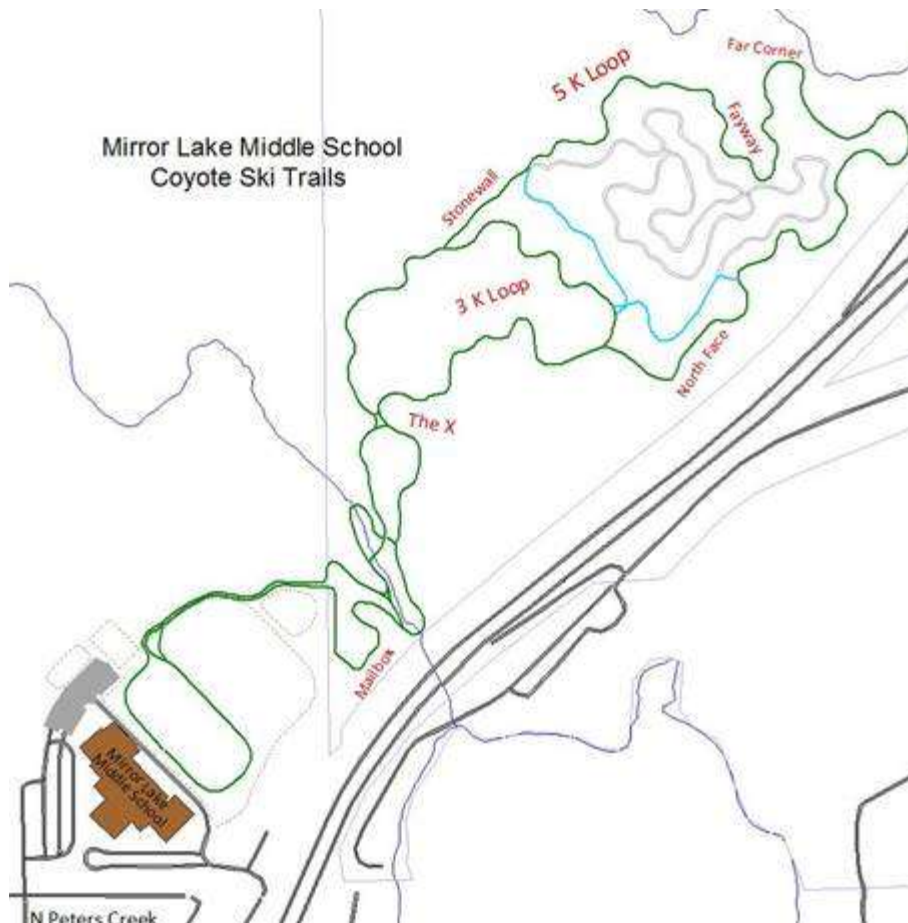


Just in time for the Ski Season: New Trails for Mirror Lake

Two new trails are completed at the Coyote Trails at Mirror Lake Middle School. Ski club volunteers and trail specialists made quick work on these two trail additions (shown in the teal) that will offer alternative routes to two steep hills... a descent known as The North Face and a climb known as Stonewall. Both these hills can be very challenging and intimidating, particularly for beginner and less aggressive skiers. These new trails will allow easier and safer access to the outer loop of the trail system and provide a nice return route to repeat the outer loop. A classic-only trail is also planned in the center of the 5 K loop. If you are familiar with the trails, we hope you will enjoy these improvements. If you have never skied them, then please come out and join us sometime this winter!
